Students will be able to choose which class(s) they want to attend and log in to view. These will be live, interactive presentations where the students will be able to ask the speakers questions directly in real time and meet all continuing education requirements. By virtue of the studio format we will be able to control the audio and video features along with the presenter's media. These are a few of features not normally available in virtual training offerings.

How does this impact you? We will be scrolling our vendors names before and after each presentation, during our 10-minute breaks between classes and also place a hyperlink to your website on our updated website.

We recognize this format does not give you the same interaction as a in person venue but with the uncertainty of Covid-19 we and our speakers feel this is the most prudent course of action. Based on this we are reducing our vendor registration significantly.
